

Fast Track to SEM Scholarship Application

The *Fast Track to SEM Scholarship* is a competitive, merit-based scholarship available only to UT Dallas undergraduates who are successfully admitted to the Systems Engineering and Management Fast Track program. The Fast Track program at UT Dallas enables qualified senior undergraduate students to include master's level courses in their undergraduate degree plans. When a successful Fast-Track student graduates with the BS degree, he or she is automatically admitted to graduate school at UT Dallas without need to take the Graduate Records Exam (GRE). The number of hours required to complete the MS degree is reduced by the number of Fast-Track graduate hours completed with grades of B or better. So, for example, a Fast-Track undergraduate who passed 12 hours of well-chosen graduate coursework with grades of A or B, would have only 33-12 = 21 hours of graduate coursework left in order to complete the MS degree.

To be eligible for the *Fast Track to SEM Scholarship*, you must satisfy the Fast Track requirements. Please consult with the Jonsson School webpages for more details and Fast Track application:

Scholarship Application Requirements:

- 1. Completed application (this form) with signature.
- 2. Letter of recommendation on letterhead from a UTD undergraduate Academic Advisor or current Faculty. Make sure to include original signature and title.
- 3. Must plan to be enrolled full time (9 credit hours) for the first graduate semester
- 4. Personal narrative statement.
- 5. ONLY completed application received by the posted deadline will be considered.

Application Deadlines:

Application is during your semester of graduation (or earlier, if you have been pre-admitted in the Fast Track program); by semester, deadlines are:

Students Graduating in Fall: April 15
Students Graduating in Spring: November 1
