

CRITERIA FACT SHEET

Systems Engineering Department Merit Scholarships

The Systems Engineering Department now offers a limited number of \$1,000 competitive, merit-based scholarships to existing graduate students in the Systems Engineering and Management degree program (SEM) who have completed at least 18 credit hours. Scholarships will be awarded for the Fall and Spring Semesters. These SEM Merit Scholarships are renewable for a second semester, subject to satisfactory academic performance and availability of funding.

All existing students in graduate studies through the Systems Engineering and Management MS degree program (www.utdallas.edu/sem/) in the Department of Systems Engineering are eligible to apply. Criteria to be considered in awarding these scholarships are:

- 1) Successful Completion of 18 Credit Hours in Systems Engineering and Management core & electives
- 2) GPA – attaining/maintaining a 3.6
- 3) Must be enrolled full time or in graduating semester.
- 4) General Citizenship such as participation in activities of student organizations related to the SEM Program.
- 5) GRE scores & Undergraduate Performance
- 6) 2 Letters of recommendation from current professors

The application deadline for Fall scholarships is April 15. Fall scholarships will be awarded by June 1 or earlier. The application deadline for Spring is November 1. Spring Scholarships will be awarded as soon as GPA can be verified. Fall grades must be posted.
